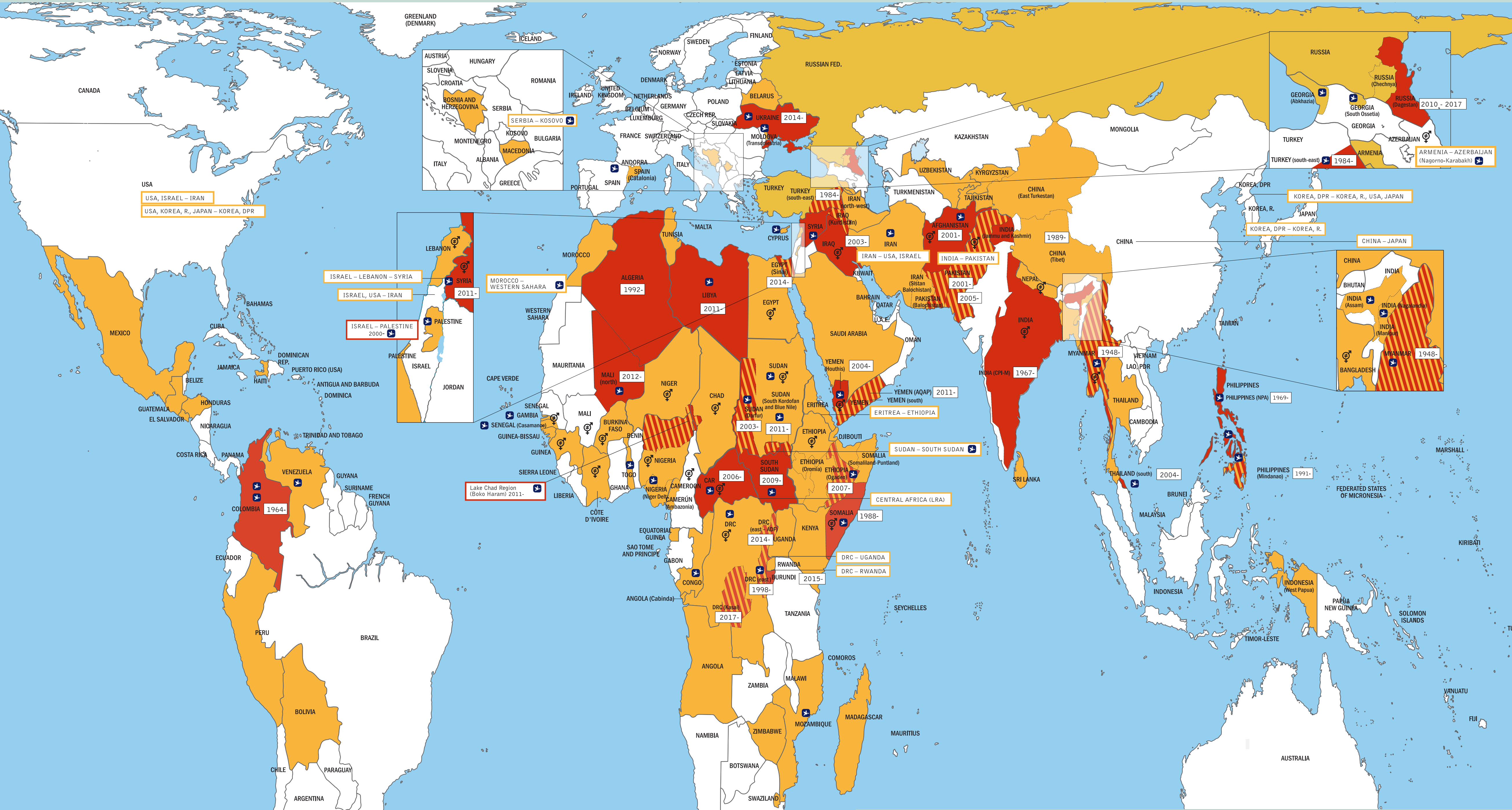


# Conflict and peacebuilding in 2017
