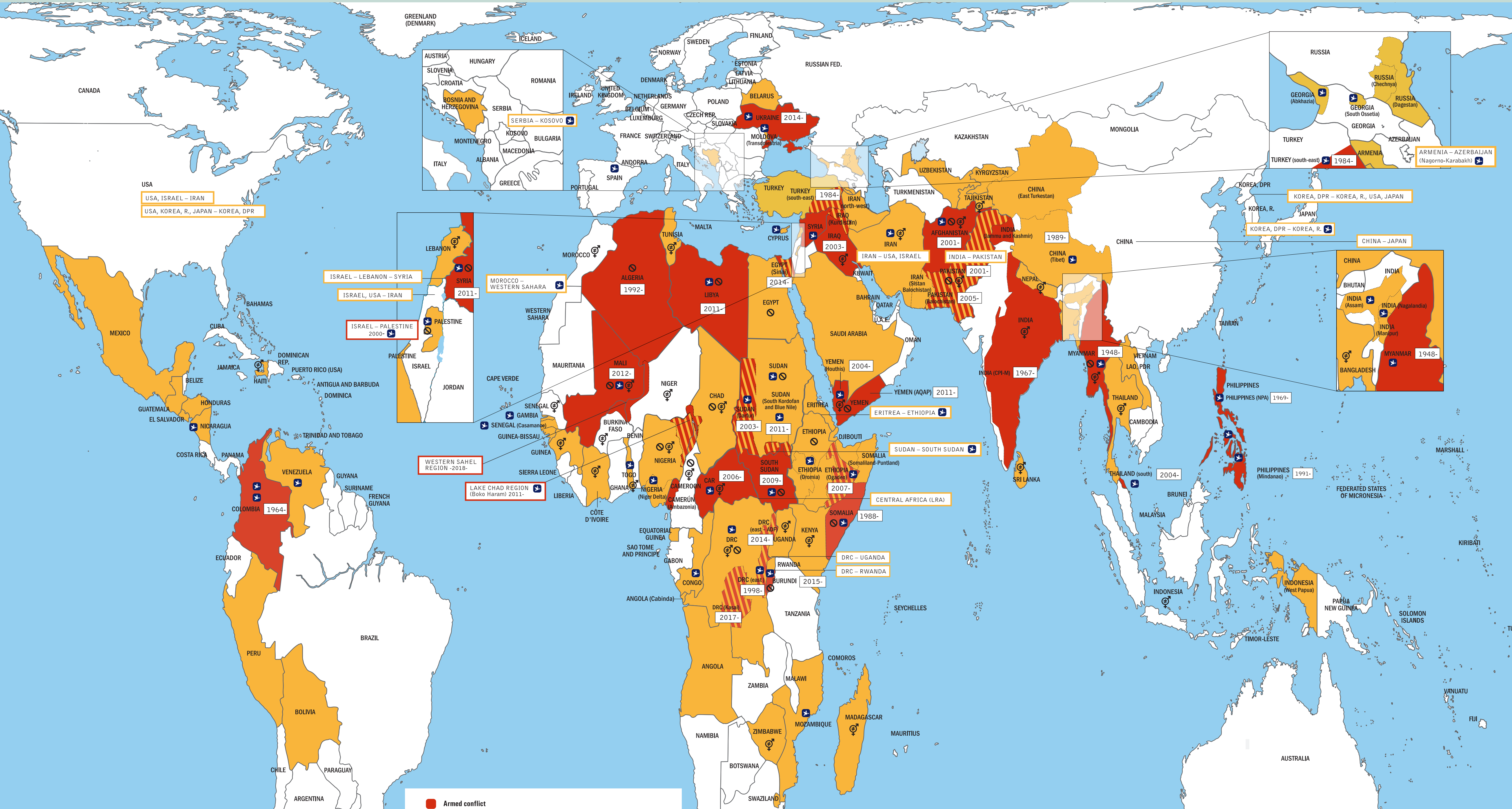

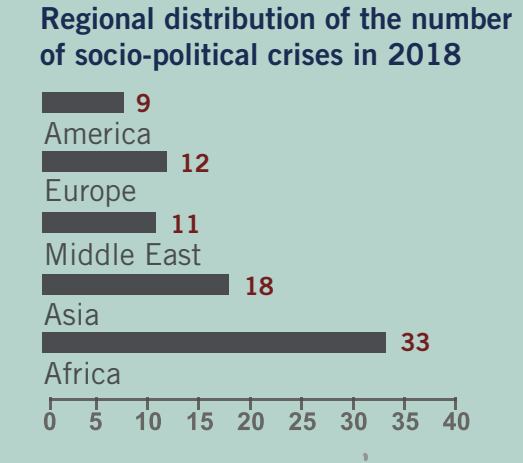
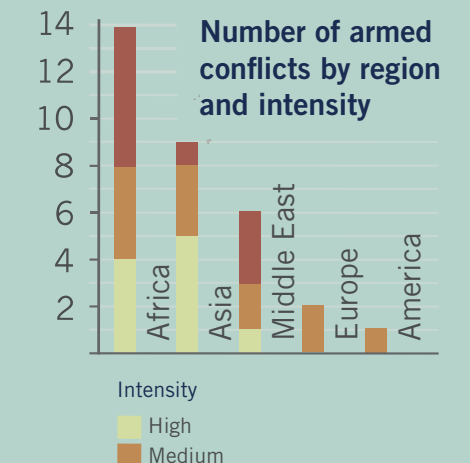
83 Socio-political crises around the world in 2018
