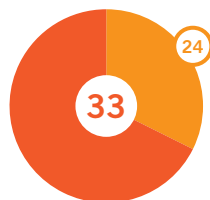

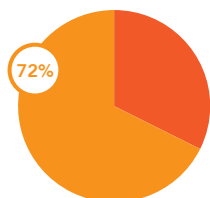

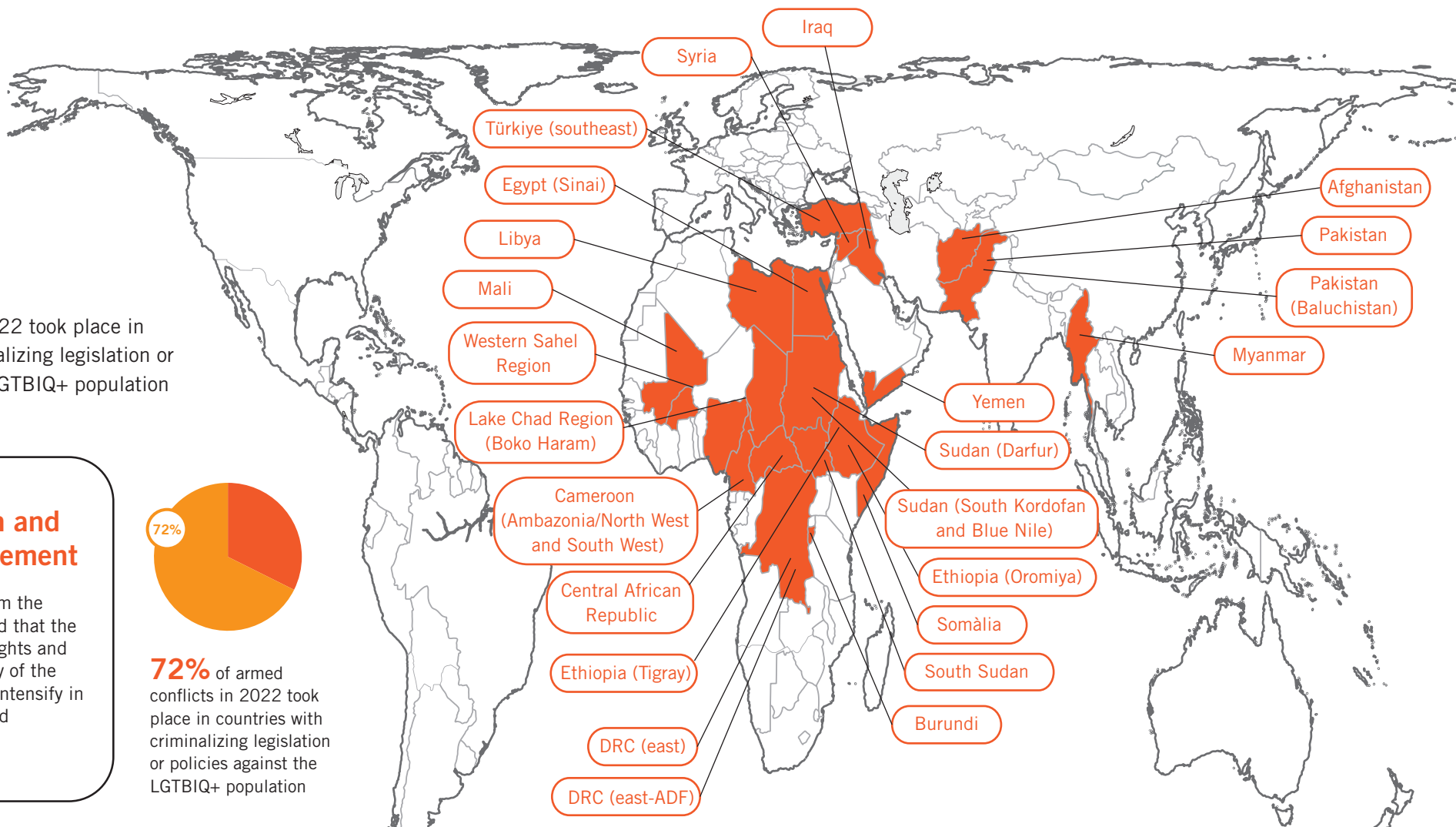

## Discrimination and forced displacement

A group of experts from the United Nations warned that the violations of human rights and structural vulnerability of the LGTBIQ+ population intensify in the processes of forced displacement
