




Armed conflicts in the world in 2022




The escalation of violence in the Oromia region (Ethiopia) led that case to be considered as a new armed conflict

At the end of June 2022, there were 82.4 million forcibly displaced people worldwide due to persecution, conflict, violence and human rights violations, according to UNHCR. This is an increase of 15% since the end of 2021.
